2. *In the beginning was the Word...* (John 1:1). John begins his gospel with a description of the One who was *in the beginning* – Jesus. What statements from John 1:1-18 reveal that Jesus is God?

- a. What do these verses say about the world's reception of *the Word*?

- b. List 5 more things we learn about Jesus from this passage (v. 1-18) that have not already been mentioned.

3. This chapter introduces us to **John the Baptist**. Summarize the testimony of John the Baptist and the purpose of his ministry from what you learn about him in John 1.
 - a. Jesus is coming again. We, as His disciples, should also be *preparing the way for Him*. What are some ways we can do that?
4. John 1:29-34 describes the events of the following day when Jesus came to John the Baptist. From these verses, record some of John the Baptist's declarations about Jesus.
5. From verses 35-51, what is the result of John pointing to Jesus?
6. What are the names of the disciples mentioned in John 1?
 - a. One of the disciples that followed Jesus was Andrew, Simon Peter's brother (verse 40). What did Andrew do after he began to follow Jesus? (See John 1:41,42.)
 - b. What did Jesus say to Philip? (verse 43)
 - 1) How have you responded to Jesus' call to *follow* Him?
