- 1. Leaving Judea, Jesus and His disciples headed toward Galilee. *But He needed to go through Samaria* (John 4:4). Jesus asked the Samaritan woman for a drink of water. What did He offer her? (verse 10)
 - a. Read John 4:14 and record what Jesus said about the living water.

- b. What does John tell us the *living water* referred to (John 7:37-39)?
- 2. It appears that the woman at the well had an unmet need for love, which she was trying to meet through relationships with different men. What does Matthew 6:8 remind us about God's awareness of our needs?
- 3. According to verses 28-29, what did the Samaritan woman do?

4.	The Samaritan woman was not a Biblical scholar, yet she led people to Christ. How does this inspire you?
5.	What did Jesus say about <i>His food</i> in verses 32 and 34?
6.	Describe the <i>work</i> Jesus referred to in John 4:35-38.
7.	Now after the two days He departed from there and went to Galilee (verse 43). A certain nobleman came to Jesus. Why? (see verses 46 and 47)
8.	What inspired you about the nobleman's faith?
9.	In what ways did this chapter speak to you about people's needs?
10.	Describe the example set by Jesus in this chapter.
