3. What conditions are given in order that we can ask and receive whatever we ask? (John 15:7)

4. What will you do to abide in Christ in a more tangible and powerful way?

5. Jesus stated in John 15:11, *These things I have spoken to you, that My joy may remain in you, and that your joy may be full.* In what ways have you discovered joy through *abiding in Christ* and *keeping His commandments*?

6. Scan through John 15:18-25 and think about how the *world hates* Jesus and His followers. How does the world display its hatred today?

7. Jesus stated in John 15:22, *If I had not come and spoken to them, they would have no sin.* In John 15:24, He says something similar. What does Jesus mean when He says *they would have no sin*?

8. Jesus promised to send the Holy Spirit, the *Helper*. What does John 15:26 say about Him?
