  - a. Jesus' claim to be the *Son of God* was proven to be true by what event? (Romans 1:3,4)
4. What was Pilate's predicament? (John 19:12)
  - a. What was Pilate's decision? (John 19:13,16)

5. The Gospel of John records three of the seven statements Jesus made while He was on the cross. According to the following verses, what were they?
