JOHN 20 - Read through the chapter and summarize each paragraph division.

- 1. Now on the first day of the week Mary Magdalene went to the tomb early (John 20:1). Upon finding the stone rolled away, she ran and came to Simon Peter, and to the other disciple (John). What did she tell them? (John 20:2)
 - a. Peter and John ran to the tomb. They discovered the linen cloths and the handkerchief that had been around His head. John 20:8 tells us that John *saw and believed*. If you had been Mary Magdalene, Peter, or John, what thoughts might have run through your mind when you discovered the empty tomb?
- 2. Peter and John went back home. But Mary remained at the tomb weeping. As she *stooped down and looked into the tomb*, what did she see (John 20:12)?
- 3. Read 1 Corinthians 15:13-19. What does Paul say the results would have been if *Christ had not risen*. NOTE: there are 7 results mentioned.

4. *Then, the same day at evening...Jesus came...where the disciples were assembled* (John 20:19). Read through this paragraph division (John 20:19-23) and record the four statements that Jesus made to His disciples.

- 5. *Now Thomas...was not with them when Jesus came* (John 20:24) and Thomas had doubts. He wanted physical proof. When you have doubts, what do you say or do?
 - a. Eight days later, Jesus again appeared to His disciples. This time Thomas was present. What does Thomas say when he sees and touches the risen Lord (John 20:28)?
 - b. Who is Jesus referring to in John 20:29?
 - 1) You have not seen, yet you believe. Why?
- 6. John closes the chapter by stating the reason he wrote this book. What was it (John 20:31)
 - a. Share a few of the things John has written in this gospel that have strengthened your *belief* in Jesus.

7. So What! What has God shown you in John 20 and what are you going to do about it?
